On April 30, 2007, the MRED admissions committee sent out 36 notices of first acceptance along with notices to 12 prioritized wait list candidates.

The program received over 350 expressions of interest during the admission period, some 120 plus applications were initiated resulting in 96 completed applications received from the Graduate College for MRED consideration.

This year's application pool continued to be predominately mid career professionals with more applications from candidates with design backgrounds than last year. Candidates with backgrounds in construction, law, business and real estate were in similar proportion to last years applicant pool.
